On May 7, 2015, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion requesting to extend the time for reporting the results of its CAISO EIM cost-benefit study from June 30, 2015 to the fourth quarter of 2015. PGE states that it is making tangible progress on its cost-benefit analysis, but that it is unable to complete the analysis by June 30, 2015. PGE states that Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and Renewable Northwest do no object to the motion.
