DISPOSITION: COMMENT DEADLINE SHORTENED

On October 26, 2018, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a motion to modify the deadlines contained in Order No. 18-360 for filing the results of its updated coal analysis. Order No. 18-360 directs PacifiCorp to take many steps to include stakeholders and the Commission in its coal analysis process, and there are three particular deadlines that are relevant to the motion:

- (1) Present the results of the updated coal analysis to Staff and stakeholders at the company's 2019 IRP public input meeting on November 1 and 2;
- (2) Hold an Oregon-specific stakeholder meeting in early November to present the results of the updated coal analysis (currently scheduled for November 8);
- (3) Work with Staff to present a summary of the results of the updated coal analysis and a summary of stakeholder feedback at a Regular Public Meeting in mid-November (currently scheduled for November 20).

PacifiCorp's motion seeks to maintain the current dates for status updates, and to move the reporting of final coal analysis results to four weeks later. For illustrative purposes, PacifiCorp seeks these changes:

- (1) Present an update on the results progress of updated coal analysis to Staff and stakeholders at the company's 2019 IRP public input meeting on November 1 and 2, and present the results of the updated coal analysis at the next meeting on December 3-4, 2018.
- (2) Hold an Oregon-specific stakeholder <u>conference call meeting</u> in early November to <u>discuss the status</u> <u>present the results</u> of the updated coal analysis (currently scheduled for November 8), <u>and hold an Oregon-specific meeting the week of</u> December 10 to review the results of the updated coal analysis;

(3) Work with Staff to present a summary of the results of the updated coal analysis and a summary of stakeholder feedback at a Regular Public Meeting on December 18, 2018.in mid-November (currently scheduled for November 20).

PacifiCorp states that it has consulted with stakeholders and is authorized to represent that Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, Renewable Northwest, Sierra Club, and Staff do not oppose this proposal. If any stakeholder opposes this request, they should file a response to the motion in this docket by close of business Monday, October 29, 2018. Chief Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Michael Grant is delegated authority to modify time lines specified in a Commission order. In the Matter of Public Utility Commission of Oregon; The Delegation of Certain Duties and Powers of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, Docket No. CD 23, Order No. 18-264 at Appendix D (Jul 10, 2018). Chief ALJ Grant intends to issue a ruling on this matter on Tuesday, October 30, 2018.
