RULING

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED.

On May 2, 2023, I issued a memorandum in this docket requesting that the parties confer and file a proposed procedural schedule for these proceedings. On May 11, 2023, Staff of the Public Utility Commission filed a proposed schedule and states that counsel for the City of Portland supports the proposed schedule. Staff also stated that neither Staff nor the City of Portland required a prehearing conference to discuss other procedural issues.

Accordingly, the procedural schedule based on Staff's proposed schedule is adopted as set forth below:

² A specific time and place for the hearing will be established at a later date as necessary.
