Petition for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

On September 1, 2022, Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) filed a Notice of Intent to File a Petition for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (Notice of Intent). Idaho Power filed its Petition and supporting testimony on September 30, 2022.

On September 20, 2022, I issued a memorandum providing details on a prehearing conference to be held on October 11, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom video conference. This memorandum serves to provide the parties and interested members of the public with additional details regarding the prehearing conference in this matter.

The Commission anticipates holding an in-person public comment hearing in eastern Oregon later this fall. While the scheduling of this event will largely be based on the availability of a suitable venue for such an event and other logistical constraints, the parties should be prepared to discuss any preferences they may have for such an in-person public comment hearing at the prehearing conference. The Commission also anticipates holding a remote, public comment hearing via Zoom video conference at a later date.

Though not required, the Commission encourages any person seeking to participate as a party in these proceedings to file a petition to intervene before the prehearing conference. *See* OAR 860-001-0300. Petitions to intervene received before the prehearing conference may be ruled upon during the conference.
