**RULING**

**DISPOSITION: PARTIES DIRECTED TO NOTIFY COMMISSION BY  
JULY 9, 2007, WHETHER A HEARING IS NECESSARY  
OR WHETHER THEY WILL FILE STIPULATED FACTS  
BY JULY 23, 2007**

On May 21, 2007, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp); Hood River Electric Cooperative, Inc. (HREC); and the Petitioners (collectively, “the parties”) filed a joint statement regarding the location of Tax Lot 501. According to the joint statement, there is no dispute among the parties concerning the location of Tax Lot 501 or the boundaries of PacifiCorp’s and HREC’s service territories. Specifically, the parties agree that:

1. PacifiCorp’s and HREC’s service territory boundary lines run across a minimal portion of the south and west portions of Tax Lot 501.
2. Whiskey Creek separates PacifiCorp’s service territory from HREC’s service territory. PacifiCorp’s service territory rests to the north of the creek, and HREC’s service territory rests to the south.
3. The proposed building site for Tax Lot 501 is to the north of Whiskey Creek, within PacifiCorp’s service territory.

Although there is no dispute concerning the utility service boundaries or the location of Tax Lot 501, it is unclear whether there are any other disputed facts that necessitate an evidentiary hearing in this matter. The parties should consult with each other regarding this matter. If relevant facts remain in dispute, I will schedule an evidentiary hearing. On the other hand, if there are no disputed facts, the parties should file a set of stipulated facts. Upon receipt of the stipulated facts, I will convene a telephone conference and establish a schedule for filing legal briefs.

Accordingly, the parties should notify my office by July 9, 2007, whether (a) an evidentiary hearing is necessary or (b) the parties will file stipulated facts. If the parties choose to file stipulated facts, that filing shall be made with the Commission no later than July 23, 2007.
