PROCEDURAL RULING

**DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME CONDITIONALLY
GRANTED**

On December 28, 2022, Paul Spies, dba Waverly Town Homes, LLC, filed a formal complaint against PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power. PacifiCorp filed an answer and motion to dismiss on January 13, 2023. Complainant was to file its response to the motion to dismiss on or before January 30, 2023.

Complainant electronically filed a letter on February 1, 2023, and requested a 10-day extension of time, in which to respond to the motion to dismiss.

The complainant stated that he was out of the office for two weeks in January without cell phone or email access and did not have an opportunity to review the motion to dismiss filed by PacifiCorp.

I conditionally grant complainant's motion for an extension of time until February 13, 2023, in which to file its response to PacifiCorp's motion to dismiss. If PacifiCorp wishes to contest the motion, it must do so within 5 business days of service of this ruling. If PacifiCorp does not contest the motion, the decision to grant the motion shall be final.
