DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE CONDITIONALLY GRANTED

On July 21, 2006, the City of Gresham ("Gresham") filed a petition to intervene in this docket. It states that up to this point, it had been participating in the case through the League of Oregon Cities ("the League") and the City of Portland ("Portland"). However, at this time, Gresham has determined that its interests vary from those represented by Portland and the League. Gresham states that it accepts the record "as is" and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceeding. It also states that Portland General Electric and several intervenors, including Portland, the League, the Citizens' Utility Board, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, have stated that they do not object to this petition.

Although the deadline for petitions to intervene in this case was set for May 12, 2006, Gresham has shown good reason for the delay in its participation. Gresham's petition is conditionally granted. Any person wishing to contest Gresham's petition may do so within 10 days of service of the petition. If no person contests the petition, this decision to grant the petition shall be final.
