DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED; PROCEEDINGS HELD IN ABEYANCE

On October 17, 2007, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) adopted a schedule in this proceeding. Pursuant to that schedule, Commission Staff (Staff) and Citizens' Utility Board (CUB) testimony were due to be filed on November 29, 2007. On November 28, 2007, Staff filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule to allow the parties additional time in which to negotiate a settlement before Staff and CUB file their testimony.

Staff represents that Idaho Power Company and CUB support the Motion and that the parties plan to meet during the next month for the purpose of conducting further settlement negotiations. Staff therefore asks that the Commission suspend the current schedule with the expectation that, during the month of December, the parties will be submitting a revised schedule or a request for a further prehearing conference.

RULING

Good cause having been shown, the procedural schedule adopted in the Conference Report of October 17, 2007, is hereby SUSPENDED. These proceedings shall be held in abeyance pending a request from parties for further Commission action.
