DISPOSITION: NOTICE TO PARTIES

On August 8, 2008, Pacific Power filed a motion on behalf of all parties to extend the procedural schedule. In its motion the Company stated:

The parties hope to be able to narrow the issues sufficiently so that the Commission may set a reasonable briefing schedule and still issue its final order in this case in time for the calculation of the Transition Adjustment associated with the November 15, 2008 direct access shopping window. However, the Company agrees not to use the direct access effective date as an argument against allowing an appropriate amount of time for briefing and a Commission decision in this case. In relation to the new schedule, the Company agrees that, if necessary, it will request a waiver of OAR 860-038-0275 (setting the direct access window on or about November 15 of each year) to change the date of the direct access window to allow sufficient time for completion of this docket.

The parties are advised that a Commission decision may not be issued before mid-November. Pacific Power may request a waiver of OAR 860-038-0275 to change the date of the direct access window, as necessary.
