
RULING

**DISPOSITION: PARTIES TO FILE MOTIONS TO ADMIT TESTIMONY
AND WITNESS AFFIDAVITS**

On September 8, 2010, after Portland General Electric Company (PGE) notified the Public Utility Commission of Oregon that the parties had settled all issues in this docket, the procedural schedule was suspended.

Because there was no hearing in this docket, pre-filed testimony has not yet been admitted into the record. Those parties who filed pre-filed testimony are ordered to file motions to admit the testimony, including witness affidavits in support of the motions, by October 8, 2010.¹
