DISPOSITION: TIME SHORTENED

By motion filed October 6, 2010, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power or the Company), requests the Public Utility Commission of Oregon approve a modified protective order in this docket "to provide additional protective measures for Highly Confidential information related to the Company's Official Forward Price Curve." The relief requested relates to data requests served by the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU).

According to Pacific Power, the materials sought by ICNU "contain among the most sensitive information maintained by the Company." Additional protection is "essential" because disclosure would harm the Company and its customers by providing suppliers and competitors with detailed information regarding how Pacific Power analyzes the markets for electricity and natural gas.

In view of the timeline remaining for this proceeding, I shorten the time for parties to reply to Pacific Power's motion. Any reply must be filed not later than October 13, 2010.
