RULING

**DISPOSITION: TIME SHORTENED**

By motion filed October 29, 2010, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power or the Company), requests the Public Utility Commission of Oregon provide direction on how the Company should implement the "Order" issued in docket UM 1355<sup>1</sup> into Pacific Power's Transition Adjustment Mechanism (TAM). Given the complexity of the potential implementation of the UM 1355 order into the Company's 2011 TAM, Pacific Power requests expedited consideration of its motion.

In view of the timeline remaining for this proceeding, I shorten the time for parties to reply to Pacific Power's motion. Any reply must be filed not later than November 5, 2010.
