RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On June 27, 2011, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion to admit the testimony of Brian Bahr out of time. The motion explains why Mr. Bahr's testimony was filed late, and offers PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power), an additional three days to file its response to the testimony.

On July 5, 2011, Pacific Power notified the Commission that it does not object to Staff's motion. At this time, Pacific Power is unsure whether it will need additional time to respond to Staff's testimony. Should Pacific Power later determine that it needs additional time to respond to Mr. Bahr's testimony, it may so inform the parties and Commission.
