RULING AND NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF TELEPHONE CONFERENCE

DISPOSITION: DEADLINES MODIFIED; TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CANCELLED

On June 8, 2011, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) filed a motion to compel responses to data requests propounded on PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power). Pacific Power was given until Monday, June 13, 2011, to respond to the motion, and a telephone conference was set for June 15, 2011.

On Monday, June 13, 2011, ICNU advised the Commission that Pacific Power has agreed to provide ICNU with additional responses to its data requests. ICNU asks for time to review the material to determine whether the motion to compel is still necessary.

In light of the parties' agreement, Pacific Power's deadline to respond to ICNU's motion is suspended, and the upcoming telephone conference is cancelled. If ICNU decides to pursue its motion to compel, it must notify the ALJ and the parties on the service list of its intention to do so via email by 5:00 pm on Wednesday, June 15, 2011. A new deadline for Pacific Power's response and a date for a telephone conference will be set thereafter.
