DISPOSITION: MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED IN PART

On April 4, 2012, Pacificorp, dba Pacific Power, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC, and Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (collectively "moving parties") filed a joint motion to modify the procedural schedule. Moving parties request that the Commission adopt the following changes to the schedule adopted on March 20, 2012: add settlement conference dates, recognize the parties' agreement to shorten the deadline for responding to data requests, include the deadline for Pacific Power's indicative NPC, and move out the dates for hearing, opening briefs, and closing briefs.

I accept all proposed changes except movement of the date for simultaneous opening and closing briefs, which would reduce the time available to the Commission to prepare and issue a decision. Accordingly, I adopt the following modified procedural schedule:
