DISPOSITION: PROCEEDINGS CONDITIONALLY SUSPENDED

On September 16, 2013, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule and, in light of the due date for notification of witnesses and the pendency of hearings, asked for expedited consideration. In support of the motion, PGE states:

Settlement discussions between PGE, Staff, CUB, and ICNU (collectively the "Stipulating Parties") were held on August 16, 2013, and continued on September 5, 2013. As a result of those discussions, an agreement in principal resolving the one remaining issue of test-year pension costs was reached among the Stipulating Parties. The Stipulating Parties are in the process of completing a stipulation and supporting joint testimony and anticipate filing the stipulation and testimony later this week.

No party has indicated its intention to offer oral testimony or ask that other parties' witnesses be made available for cross-examination. In order to provide the parties with the opportunity to resolve the issues in this docket, while simultaneously avoiding undue delay, the proceedings are conditionally suspended; the motion is granted subject to the condition that no objections are received by close of business Thursday, September 19, 2013.

The parties shall file with the Commission either the anticipated stipulation, along with the supporting documentation as required by OAR 860-001-0350(7)(a) and (b), or a status report, no later than September 23, 2013.
