RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

The following parties have filed petitions to intervene in this docket: Shell Energy North America (US), L.P. (Shell Energy); Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.; and the Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC). Upon review of the petitions, I find that Shell Energy, Constellation NewEnergy, and NIPPC have sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that their participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.¹ The petitions to intervene are therefore granted.
