RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On April 4 and April 10, 2014, respectively, the NW Energy Coalition (NVEC and Fred Meyer Stores, a subsidiary of the Kroger Co. and Quality Food Centers (Kroger) filed petitions to intervene in this docket. Upon review of the petitions, I find that NVEC and Kroger have sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that their participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.¹ The petitions to intervene are therefore granted.
