DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED; STIPULATION OR STATUS REPORT TO BE FILED

By ruling of July 20, 2015, the procedural schedule for the main portion of the docket was suspended and a schedule was established for addressing a power cost issue related to planned outages at the Port Westward 1 generation facility. Pursuant to the schedule, Portland General Electric Company filed supplemental testimony on July 24, 2015 and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and the Commission Staff filed supplemental testimony on August 5, 2015.

On August 12, 2015, PGE filed a motion to suspend the remaining procedural schedule. In support of the motion, PGE noted that on August 7, 2015, the company, Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, the Small Business Utility Advocates, and ICNU (stipulating parties) participated in settlement discussions and have reached a settlement with respect to the power cost issue referred to in the company's July 14, 2015 motion. The stipulating parties represent that they are drafting a stipulation agreement and supporting testimony and will file them as soon as completed. They therefore propose that the current schedule for the remaining portion of the case be suspended.

Good cause having been shown, the schedule for the remaining portion of the docket is suspended. The parties shall file a stipulation and testimony or a status report no later than August 28, 2015.
