Request for General Rate Revision.

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE MODIFED

On September 6, 2018, Portland General Electric filed an unopposed motion to modify the procedural schedule for this docket. PGE represents that a fifth settlement agreement in principle has been reached.

The prehearing conference memorandum issued on March 20, 2018, requires that PGE's surrebuttal testimony be filed on Friday, September 7, 2018 and prehearing briefs be filed on September 12, 2018. PGE represents that the number of outstanding issues not subject to a settlement agreement is limited. Accordingly, PGE requests that:

- 1. The date for prehearing briefs be removed from the schedule, and
- 2. The parties be directed to file cross-examination statements, and cross examination exhibits, if any, by September 14.

PGE states that Staff, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers support the motion. For good cause shown, PGE's motion is granted. The date for prehearing briefs is removed from the schedule, and parties are directed to file cross-examination statements, and cross-examination exhibits by September 14, 2018. The rest of the schedule remains unchanged.
