DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED

On September 5, 2019, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power filed a motion to amend the stipulation filed on August 1, 2019. PacifiCorp states that the company discovered typographical errors on page five of the stipulation that referenced confidential exhibit PAC/204 rather than Attachment A, Settlement PAC/401. PacifiCorp indicates that the company conferred with Staff, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB), the Alliance of Western Energy, Consumers (AWEC), Calpine Energy Solutions LLC (Calpine Solutions), and the Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA), (collectively the other stipulating parties) and represents that the other stipulating parties support this motion.

Additionally, in the stipulation filed on August 1, 2019, the stipulating parties agreed that the company would file a final cost update one month in advance of the October 1, 2019 effective date for rates. The company submitted its cost update on September 3, 2019, marked as "September 1, 2019 update to Exhibit PAC/401." PacifiCorp subsequently redesignated this exhibit as Exhibit PAC/1100. On September 5, 2019, the company filed a motion to supplement the record in this proceeding, seeking to admit the cost update, Exhibit PAC/1100, into the record. PacifiCorp additionally filed a supporting declaration by its witness regarding the cost update.

For good cause shown, PacifiCorp's motion to amend the stipulation and PacifiCorp's motion to supplement the record and admit Exhibit PAC/1100 is granted. I find that Exhibit PAC/1100 offered by PacifiCorp and supported by the declaration of its witness meets the standards for relevance as required by OAR 860-001-0450(1) and satisfies the requirements of OAR 860-001-0480.
