RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED,
MOTIONS TO ADMIT PRE-FILED TESTIMONY REQUESTED**

On October 21, 2019, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC) filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule. AWEC proposes that the scheduled date for simultaneous opening briefs be moved from November 7, 2019 to November 14, 2019. AWEC explains that the change will allow the parties additional time to receive the transcript of the hearing in the docket and to incorporate it into their briefing.

In support of its request, AWEC states that it has conferred with all parties to the proceeding and that all parties either support or do not oppose the motion.

RULING

For good cause shown, the motion is granted. The schedule is amended as outlined below and simultaneous briefs are due November 14, 2019. All other remaining dates in the procedural schedule remain unchanged; however I add a date to the schedule by which motions to admit pre-filed testimony are requested.
