2020 Annual Power Cost Update Tariff (Schedule 125).

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On May 20, 2019, a procedural schedule was adopted in this docket. On August 2, 2019, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and requested expedited consideration. In its motion, PGE states that the parties to this docket, PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, recently held settlement discussions and had reached an agreement settling all issues in this docket.

PGE further states that the parties are in the process of drafting a stipulation and supporting joint testimony to be submitted to the Commission, and that all of the parties support PGE's motion

Because Staff and intervenor rebuttal testimony is due August 6, 2019 under the previously-adopted schedule, I find that good cause exists to grant PGE's motion on an expedited basis.

RULING

The motion of Portland General Electric Company to suspend the procedural schedule is granted. The parties shall file a joint stipulation and supporting testimony or a joint status report no later than September 6, 2019.
