RULING

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE MODIFIED

On May 29, 2020, I issued a ruling modifying portions of the procedural schedule as follows:

I further stated that

in the event that the parties are unanimous in their intention to waive their respective rights to cross-examine witnesses, the hearing shall be canceled, and the parties shall file proposed dates for the presentation of oral argument before the Commission on all outstanding issues. On June 1, 2020, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC) filed a motion to modify procedural schedule and requested expedited consideration, asking that the newly-adopted date of June 5, 2020 for the filing of cross-examination statements revert to the previous June 9, 2020 deadline.

In support of the motion, AWEC states that the June 5 date would deprive staff and intervenors the opportunity to acquire evidence via responses to data requests arising out of PGE's surrebuttal testimony and to include such exhibits in their cross-examination statements. AWEC further states that all parties support its motion and are agreeable to a change in the scheduled hearing date if the Commission concludes that additional time is necessary.

RULING

I find that AWEC has shown good cause for granting its motion. The motion is granted.

The date that cross-examination statements, including the intention to waive cross-examination, are due is changed from June 5, 2020 to June 9, 2020.

All other dates in the schedule remain unchanged.
