**DISPOSITION: PARTIES ADVISED REGARDING ORAL ARGUMENT FORMAT**

On August 6, 2020, a Notice of Hearing (Oral Argument) was scheduled in these dockets to be held on August 17, 2020, at 9:30 a.m., via telephone conference.

There are three open issues which must be addressed by the Commission in these proceedings. For this oral argument, the Commissioners would like to focus the parties on the issue of including customer protections and benefits in rates. Commissioners may ask questions on the other open issues at the end of the argument.
