DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL PRO HAC VICE GRANTED

The motion to admit Rose Monahan as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.<sup>1</sup>
