RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED**

On July 7, 2020, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. PacifiCorp states the parties to this proceeding have reached a full settlement in principle, and the parties intend to file a stipulation and supporting testimony by August 11, 2020.

PacifiCorp requests expedited consideration. PacifiCorp states the following parties do not oppose the motion: Commission Staff, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC), Calpine Solutions, LLC, Vitesse, LLC, Klamath Water Users Association, Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC), and Sierra Club.

**RULING**

I find that there is good cause to suspend the procedural schedule on an expedited basis. PacifiCorp's motion is granted.
