**DISPOSITION: EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED AND MOTION TO ADMIT
ROSE MONAHAN COUNSEL PRO HAC VICE GRANTED**

On May 11, 2020, Sierra Club filed an unopposed expedited motion seeking a one day extension of time for Staff and intervenors to file opening testimony and exhibits. Sierra Club seeks to move the due date from Thursday, May 14, 2020 to Friday, May 15, 2020. Sierra Club states the extension of time will allow it to incorporate information from the May 12, 2020 Commission workshop on coal fueling.

For good cause shown, the motion is granted. Staff and intervenor testimony is due on Friday, May 15, 2020. The remainder of the procedural schedule is unchanged.

Sierra Club also filed a motion to allow Rose Monahan to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Rose Monahan states that she will associate with Joshua Smith, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar. I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Rose Monahan as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.
