DISPOSITION: MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On July 14, 2022, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in these proceedings. PacifiCorp states that the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, Calpine Solutions, LLC, Vitesse, LLC, Klamath Water Users Association/Oregon Farm Bureau Federation, Sierra Club, Commission Staff, and PacifiCorp have developed a full settlement of all issues in this docket. PacifiCorp states that suspending the schedule will allow for the filing of a settlement and supporting testimony. Due to the July 20, 2022 deadline for Staff and Intervenor rebuttal testimony in the existing schedule, PacifiCorp requests expedited consideration of this motion under OAR 860-001-420(6). No party opposes PacifiCorp's motion to suspend the procedural schedule.

For good cause shown, I grant PacifiCorp's motion. The procedural schedule for this docket is hereby suspended. PacifiCorp represents that the settling parties anticipate filing a stipulation and supporting testimony no later than August 3, 2022. Accordingly, in the event that a stipulation is not filed by <u>3:00 p.m. on August 3, 2022</u>, the settling parties must file a status report instead.
