RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ACCEPT LATE-FILED TESTIMONY GRANTED

On June 23, 2023, the Natural Resource Defense Council and NW Energy Coalition (NRDC/NWEC) filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept NRDC/NWEC's late-filed opening testimony. NRDC/NWEC explains that it timely emailed the testimony to the parties prior to the filing deadline, and subsequently discovered that the Filing Center was inadvertently omitted from that email. NRDC/NWEC explains that all other parties timely received the testimony via email, with the exception of Staff. NRDC/NWEC states that the testimony is 24 pages long, contains no additional substantive exhibits, and is narrowly focused, so that no party will be prejudiced by the late filing. NRDC/NWEC explains it made good faith efforts to confer with other parties regarding its request and represents that as of the filing its motion, no party had objected and most have indicated no objection.

I grant NRDC/NWEC's motion and accept the late-filed testimony.
