On April 24, 2024, Idaho Power Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. Idaho Power states the parties have reached a settlement in principle resolving most issues and that a suspension of the procedural schedule would allow the parties time to discuss the final issue and to potentially finalize and execute a settlement stipulation and supporting testimony. Idaho Power states all current parties support the motion.

For good cause, I grant the motion and suspend the procedural schedule. The dates included in my April 23, 2024, memorandum remain in effect. Further, Idaho Power must file a settlement update shortly after the next settlement conference.
