DISPOSITION: EXTENSION GRANTED THROUGH APRIL 5, 2024

On March 29, 2024, close to 3:00 p.m., Portland General Electric (PGE) filed a motion for extension of time to file its proposed tariff changes for new large load connections, currently due today. PGE states that it communicated that it would seek relief to counsel for Staff, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC), and Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB). The company represents that Staff does not oppose the motion and that CUB and AWEC stated they no position on the motion.

Because the presiding Administrative Law Judge is unavailable and is most familiar with the issues and timetable associated with this case, I grant PGE an extension of time to file until April 5, 2024. The presiding Administrative Law Judge will review the motion before April 5, and either approve the motion as proposed by PGE, or request more information before doing so.
