On April 20, 2004, a telephone conference was held in the three dockets identified above. The purpose of the conference was to address a motion by the Utility Reform Project (URP) and Morgan, Gearhart and Kafoury Brothers, LLC (MGK) to extend the procedural schedule in these proceedings.

Appearances were entered as follows: Stephanie Andrus and Marc Hellman appeared on behalf of Commission Staff; Dan Meek appeared on behalf of URP; Linda Williams appeared on behalf of MGK; and Jeanne Chamberlain, Jay Dudley, Doug Tingey and Randy Dahlgren appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE).

URP and MGK further explained circumstances regarding the need for an extension, explaining that additional time was needed to engage potential expert witnesses and to prepare testimony. Concerns were expressed about whether the requested three weeks would be sufficient for URP and MGK to complete testimony, and about the need to develop a firm procedural schedule for the future. I declined to change the procedural order of testimony, affirming that Staff and Intervenors will file testimony simultaneously.
