RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

By motion filed December 3, 2010, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or Company) requests leave to file supplemental testimony and an exhibit in this matter. The subject materials are attached to the motion.

As grounds for its motion, Avista states it became aware of the need to correct an error in the federal income tax amount included in its original filing and to update for the forecasted number of customers and usage levels expected for 2011. The net effect of these revisions is to increase Avista's "justified" revenue requirement by about \$983,000. However, the Company states that is not revising its tariff filing to request additional rate relief beyond the amount of the increase originally requested (\$5.4 million).

Avista states that no party will be prejudiced by receipt of this information, noting that the filing date for Staff and intervenor testimony is more than two months out. Avista states that it has contacted all parties to the proceeding regarding the subject of its motion, and that no party objects.

For good cause shown, Avista's motion is granted. Avista is given leave to file the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Elizabeth M. Andrews (exhibit 1000 and accompanying exhibit 1001).
