## DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ADOPTED

On September 5, 2018, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a telephone prehearing conference in this docket. Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural), the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff), the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB), and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC) all noted their appearances for the record.

It was noted that supporting testimony for the all-party partial stipulation filed on August 6, 2018, had not yet been filed with the Commission. Also, it was noted that a tentative settlement between NW Natural, Staff, and CUB, with respect to two of the three remaining outstanding issues (the "three-party stipulation"), had not yet been reduced to a stipulated agreement or filed with the Commission. Further, it was noted that AWEC had the right to file objections or request a hearing with respect to the three-party stipulation.

At the conference, AWEC formally waived its right to a hearing on the three-party stipulation. All parties indicated that they do not request an oral argument before the Commission on the allparty stipulation or the three-party stipulation or any outstanding issues. Accordingly, the parties agreed to the following schedule:
