DISPOSITION: MOTIONS TO ADMIT COUNSEL PRO HAC VICE GRANTED

On January 30, 2024, the Coalition of Communities of Color, Climate Solutions, Verde, Columbia Riverkeeper, Oregon Environmental Council, Community Energy Project, and Sierra Club (Environmental Intervenors) filed motions to allow Noorulanne Jan, Michael Mayer, and Kristen L. Boyles to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in these proceedings. Noorulanne Jan, Michael Mayer, and Kristen L. Boyles state that they will associate with Carra L.
