RULING

**DISPOSITION: ORAL ARGUMENT PROCEDURE ADOPTED;
MOTION GRANTED**

An oral argument is scheduled in this proceeding for November 12, 2008, beginning at 1:30 p.m. A notice accompanies this ruling. The procedure for the oral argument is set as follows:

Opening Argument – Wah Chang, 30 minutes
Response – Pacific Power, 30 minutes.

The time allowed to each party includes any time needed for questions and answers from the Commissioners. Wah Chang may reserve up to ten minutes of its opening argument to reply to Pacific Power.

Additional time may be added, at the discretion of the Commissioners.

By motion filed October 14, 2008, Wah Chang requests that the Commission admit into evidence materials provided by Wah Chang and Pacific Power in response to queries to the parties made by the administrative law judge. The specific materials are attached to the motion.
