
RULING

DISPOSITION: DOCKET SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On April 4, 2011, Pacificorp dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power) filed a letter with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) in the above-captioned docket. The letter informs the Commission of an all-party settlement in principle among Pacific Power, Commission Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (the Settling Parties).

The Settling Parties anticipate filing a stipulation with supporting documentation by April 22, 2011, and request abeyance of the docket's schedule. In anticipation of a stipulation being filed in this docket, I suspend the procedural schedule.
