DISPOSITION: EVIDENCE ADMITTED; RECORD CLOSED


On April 22, 2011, a stipulation was filed with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) in the above-captioned proceeding on behalf of PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power), Staff of the Commission (Staff), the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB), and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU). On April 25, 2011, Joint Testimony in Support of Stipulation (joint testimony) was also filed. On April 25, 2011, Pacific Power also filed a motion to admit the stipulation and the joint testimony. Subsequent to submission of the stipulation and joint testimony, each of the parties to the stipulation filed affidavits attesting to the truthfulness and accuracy of pre-filed testimony, as well as motions to admit the pre-filed testimony and exhibits, and the stipulation and joint testimony.
