DISPOSITION: MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On May 12, 2004, Administrative Law Judge Traci Kirkpatrick granted Staff's motion to modify the procedural schedule. On May 18, 2004, Staff again requested a modification to the procedural schedule, asking that the filing date for Staff and Intervenor testimony be changed from May 20, 2004 to May 27, 2004.

Staff represents that an additional week is needed to complete negotiations regarding the appropriate method to calculate the transition adjustment for PacifiCorp's Fall 2004 window. Additional time is necessary due to the unavailability of an analyst and the need for parties to model the various proposals.

PacifiCorp and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities support Staff's request. Staff further represents that all parties to the proceeding have been notified of the motion, and no party has objected.

In Judge Kirkpatrick's absence, I am granting the motion. The new procedural schedule is:

Staff and intervenor testimony due	May 27, 2004
PacifiCorp files reply testimony	June 24, 2004
Hearing	July 1, 2004
Opening briefs due	July 20, 2004
Closing briefs due	July 30, 2004

The dates for filing are considered "in hand" dates.
