MEMORANDUM

**DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE FOR ORAL ARGUMENT SET**

Oral arguments are set for 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 14, 2004. The procedure is set as follows: Central Lincoln People's Utility District (CLPUD) will have 20 minutes, and can set aside part of that time for rebuttal; Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) will follow with 20 minutes; and Oregon Cable Telecommunications Association (OCTA) will have 20 minutes. CLPUD can then close with whatever time it has remaining for rebuttal. Staff is to be available for questions if needed.

The Commissioners have expressed a particular interest in Verizon's counter-complaint and related cost provisions under ORS 757.279 and ORS 759.660, OCTA's arguments, and other arguments that this case rises about the administrative rules and how the Commission reviews pole attachment agreements. The parties should be prepared to respond to Commissioner questions.
