DISPOSITION: NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION WITHDRAWN; MR. MEEK DIRECTED TO FILE INFORMATION

On October 4, 2004, I issued a notice of ex parte contact regarding communications between Dan Meek and Commissioner Baum during a luncheon at the Beaverton Rotary. I issued the notice after Dan Meek failed to follow through with a commitment made to Commissioner Baum to file information to the Commission concerning what Mr. Meek acknowledged was an ex parte communication.

Due to the failure of Mr. Meek to provide the promised information, I relied solely on Commissioner Baum's summary of the discussion. Commissioner Baum indicated that Mr. Meek appeared with a woman who evidently was misidentified as Linda Williams. Mr. Meek has objected to this misidentification and the resulting inaccuracy of the notice of ex parte communication.

Based on Mr. Meek's objection, I withdraw the October 4, 2004 notice of ex parte communication. With this ruling, I direct Mr. Meek to file the information he previously committed to submit to clarify this matter. In this filing, which must be received by 5:00 PM on Monday, October 11, 2004, Mr. Meek should: (1) identify whether the woman with whom he appeared is associated with a party in the case; (2) if so, identify that relationship; and (3) provide a summary of the matters discussed. With this new information, I will issue a new notice of ex parte communication.
