DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE CONDITIONALLY GRANTED

On July 29, 2005, Portland Metropolitan Association of Building Owners and Managers (BOMA) filed a Petition to Intervene (Petition). On July 28, 2005, the City of West Linn and the City of Salem each filed Petitions, both asserting that Portland General Electric Company (PGE) provides electricity to their cities and their residents, and uses their rights of way. On July 21, 2005, Enron Corporation (Enron) filed a Petition, stating that it owns all of PGE's stock and has an interest in how the stock is distributed. These parties have knowledge and expertise that will assist the Commission in resolving the issues presented in this proceeding. The parties assert that their participation in this proceeding will not unduly broaden the issues or burden the record.

The Petitions are conditionally granted. Any person wishing to contest a Petition may do so within 10 days of service of the Petition. If no person contests these Petitions, this decision shall be final.
