DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE GRANTED

On September 2, 2005, Pacific Power & Light (PacifiCorp) filed a letter seeking a delay in its Request for Proposals (RFP) review process. While no formal schedule has been adopted in this proceeding, PacifiCorp notes that Order No. 91-1383 contemplates that the review process for draft RFPs will be approximately 60 days with a Commission public meeting for Staff and party comment. PacifiCorp requests this standard process be extended 30 days, so that the Commission consideration of the draft RFP 2009 be conducted at the October 25, 2005 Public Meeting. PacifiCorp explains that this additional time will provide the company an opportunity to better ascertain and communicate with all parties what impact, if any, load curtailment renewals and Qualifying Facilities contract assumptions will have on its forecasted resource gap for 2009. Staff does not oppose the request.

I treat the letter as a motion to amend the schedule and grant the extension.
