**DISPOSITION: PETITION GRANTED** 

On May 23, 2006, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) filed a Petition to Intervene (Petition) in this case. ICNU represents that its customers may be impacted by the resolution of this complaint and its effect "on the rates that PGE provides to ICNU's members." Petition, 2. ICNU further states that it "will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding." *Id*.

This case involves a complaint, filed by the City of Portland against Portland General Electric Company. Complaint cases involve issues raised between two parties, and the issues in this case have not yet been narrowed by those parties. ICNU, and any other intervenor, will be bound by the issues raised by the Complainant and Defendant and may not raise additional issues. Subject to those constraints, the petition to intervene is granted.
