DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE CHANGE ADOPTED

On October 4, 2007, I granted a motion to vacate the schedule and set a workshop for November 1, 2007. I directed the parties to confer at the workshop and propose a new schedule.

By letter dated November 1, 2007, from Michael Weirich, attorney for the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) Staff, I am advised that the parties met on November 1, 2007, and agreed to a schedule. The proposed schedule is as follows: December 21, 2007, deadline for a party to formally submit a new proposal and for PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power and Northwest and Intermountain Power Producer's Coalition (NIPPC) to submit refinements to proposals previously submitted to the Commission on September 13, 2007; and January 29, 2008, deadline for a party to submit comments on: (1) the proposals submitted by Pacific Power and NIPPC on September 13, 2007; (2) the refinements (if any) by Pacific Power or NIPPC to their previous proposals; and (3) any new proposals submitted by December 21, 2007.

The proposed schedule is adopted.
