DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE MODIFIED

At a Prehearing Conference held November 6, 2008, a schedule for this proceeding was adopted which set February 23, 2009, as the date by which Opening Testimony was to be filed. On February 20, 2009, counsel for Commission Staff filed a Motion to Modify Schedule and requested expedited consideration. In support of its Motion, Staff states that the parties need additional time to prepare due to conflicting work schedules and case loads. Staff notes that all parties have been notified and either support or have indicated that they will not interpose any objection to the Motion.

RULING

I find that good cause has been shown to delay the date for submission of Opening Testimony and that the case as a whole will not be unduly burdened or delayed. The Motion is GRANTED. Opening Testimony shall be filed by all parties no later than April 7, 2009. The remaining dates on the schedule are unchanged.
