
RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

In preparation for a hearing scheduled on January 14, 2009, in the above captioned docket, I requested that Staff and parties submit cross-examination statements by January 4, 2010. On December 24, 2009, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) requested that the deadline for submittal of cross-examination statements be extended to January 6, 2010. PGE explained that the scope of cross-examination may be affected by a settlement conference that is scheduled for the afternoon of January 4, 2010.

I agree that time should be allowed after the settlement conference to determine the scope of cross-examination. PGE's motion is granted. Cross-examination statements are due by 5:00 p.m. on January 6, 2010.
