RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

Additional petitions to intervene have been filed in these dockets. In docket UM 1442, Biomass One, LP, and Portland General Electric Company (PGE) seek party status. In docket UM 1443, PacifiCorp, dba and Pacific Power, and PGE seek party status.

PGE's petition to intervene in Docket UM 1443 is unnecessary. As a named party to the proceeding, PGE has already been designated as a party. That petition is dismissed as unnecessary.

In the remaining petitions, I find that these parties have sufficient interest in the proceeding and that their appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. Accordingly, the petitions are granted. *See* OAR 860-012-0001.
