Staff Recommendation to Use Oregon Electricity Regulators Assistance Project Funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to Develop Commission Smart Grid Objectives for 2010-2014.

DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On July 6, 2001, the Energy Trust of Oregon (ETO) filed a petition to intervene in these proceedings. The period to respond to the petition has passed, and no objections were received. I have reviewed the petition and find that ETO has sufficient interest in the proceedings and that its participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings. *See* OAR 860-001-0300.
